



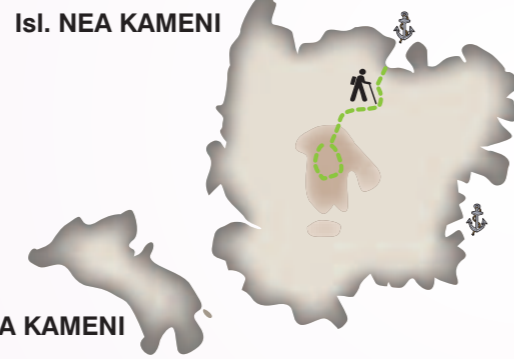

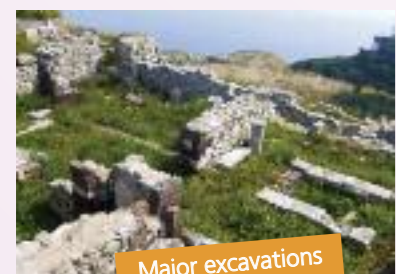

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Fira

The capital of the island! Built on the edge of the caldera, this capital boasts of having everything: banks, museums, shops, restaurants, clubs, hotels, Orthodox and Catholic churches, etc. But most importantly, it's got the vibe of Greece's cosmopolitan center. Enjoy a quiet stroll to shop through the narrow streets, sip a coffee or drinks with volcano views or go for the famous late night entertainment in the center. Fira caters for all tastes, ages and nationalities

Imerovigli

The famous village along the ridge of the caldera. Cave houses and luxury hotels swing in

a magical way between the sea and the sky offering sweeping views to the volcano, the Aegean Sea and the imposing rock of Skaros.

Pyrgos

Pyrgos is approximately 7.5 km from Fira and is one of the most traditional and aristocratic villages of Santorini. Built on a hill and surrounded by vineyards, Pyrgos dominates the island.

Oia

Maybe Santorini's most popular village, especially during the famous sunset. Colorful cave houses and hotels, restaurants and shops make up the beautiful mosaic that welcomes thousands of visitors daily.

Ancient Thera

In Ancient Thira we can see all the stages of society development in Santorini and the settlers' succession from the 7th century BC until the Byzantine period. The Spartan king Theras who first colonized the island gave Santorini its official name: **Thera**

Akrotiri

One of the most impressive archaeological sites worldwide. The prehistoric town of Akrotiri is often compared to Pompeii, although it is about 1,700 years older. It was buried, after the volcanic eruption of 1613 BC, under tons of ash and remained buried for nearly 3,500 years.
